- 1. Scott Seiter determined that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order.
- 2. Motion to approve minutes of 12-12-17 made by B. Burwell, seconded by L. Patrick. Approved unanimously.
- 3. Program Coordinator's Report
  - a. Financial Report
    i. No equipment purchases

     Scott Seiter suggested we may need to acquire a CoreDry apparatus in FY 2020.
    - ii. FY 2020 beginning balance about \$300,000.

- b. Written exams are now administered online through the OSU system for modules on campus as well as Alternate Certifications in the field.
- c. ODOT will join MTRAC, the Multi Regional Training and Certification organization for the mid-western states.
- 4. Steve Sawyer requested approval to purchase polo shirts with an HCMTCB logo for staff, inspectors, and evaluators. Motion to approve by L. Patrick, seconded by C. Mahanay. Approved unanimously.
- 5. Scott Seiter requested recognition of the ACI Aggregates certification in the same way the ACI Concrete certification is currently recognized by the program. There was discussion of the Board requirement to demonstrate the ODOT dust coating test, OHD L-48, on chip seal aggregates. Larry Patrick explained the history of the requirement and that the test was rarely used with today's cleaner materials. The test still has a use for chip seal jobs but it is an uncommon test. It was also brought to the Board's attention that the components of OHD L-48 were already included in other tests required for the Aggregates Certification by both the HCMTCB and ACI. Scott Seiter asked if any member would be opposed to removing OHD L-48 from the Aggregates Certification requirements. There was no objection.

Mr. Seiter requested that technicians certified in Aggregates through ACI be certified by the Board at a reduced fee with the practical exam eliminated and only the written exam required. The Program Coordinator was instructed to research the law and rules applicable to Mr. Seiter's suggestions and report to the Board at the next meeting on how they were or would be implemented.
